NEW APPLICANTS

New Applicants can submit a *Tenant Profile Sheet and Application* to be placed on the waitlist. As Management confirms additional spaces students will be emailed off of the waitlist to fill those spots.

HOUSING OFFER

Housing offers will be made to applicants via email as openings are confirmed.

LICENSE SIGNING

Students who have been notified via e-mail that they received a bed space need to submit a signed *License, \$300.00 Reservation fee, Housing Acceptance form, Meningitis form, Parental Guarantee form, and a copy of Guarantor's driver's license* to secure a bed space.

Offers will continue throughout the semester and summer until all spots are filled.

Assignments will be based on rules noted below.
